

Follow these instructions from the School Council on how to set up your healthier tuckshop.



1. Name it

Decide what you want to call your tuckshop. Are you going to name it after where it is or what it sells?

For example: **Pears at the stairs,**
or **The Crunchy Carrot.**



4. When?

- When will you open your shop? Will it be every day? Will it be before or after school?
- Who will look after your shop? You might want to have a rota so that you can help in the shop on one day, but still be able to go out to play on another day.



2. Research

- Find out what products your school mates will buy. Use a tally chart to find out what foods people like and a bar chart to show how popular each food is.
- You can also ask your friends to find out what their parents will let them buy.
- Find out how much money your friends have to spend.



5. Prices

- Create a price list to display by your shop.
- Ask a teacher to help you order your fruit, veg, drinks or cheeses from Kids Fruit.
- Remember to wash your hands before selling your produce.
- Choose one person to handle the money. This person should not touch the food.



3. Where?

Decide where you will put your tuckshop. Will it be in a classroom, the canteen or a corridor? It needs to be somewhere where everyone is allowed to be.



6. Labels

You will need some labels for your tuckshop to show the names and prices of the food on display. Cut out the labels from the sheet and fill them in.
